



# NEW UNIFORM



## Dress Code

<b>Blazer</b>	Green with School badge; may be removed during break/lunch.												
<b>Shirt</b>	White, long or short-sleeved; must remain tucked in; undergarments/T-shirts must not be visible through shirt.												
<b>Skirt</b>	Below knee, dark green/black, tartan and pleated School skirt (box pleats).												
<b>Trousers</b>	Formal, black, tailored, no turn-ups; jeans, informal or skin-tight trousers not permitted.												
<b>Tights</b>	Plain, skin-coloured, or black.												
<b>Socks</b>	Plain black, unbranded, ankle-length.												
<b>Tie</b>	Green/Red/Gold, striped School tie, properly tied with length just above waistband. Top button must be fastened and not visible.												
<b>Jumper</b>	Plain grey, V-neck, knitted with long sleeves. Can be worn in addition to blazer but not on its own. Sweatshirts not permitted.												
<b>Shoes</b>	Formal plain black leather or simulated leather, with low heel. Not permitted: Branded (eg. Nike, Adidas etc.), coloured or canvas shoes/trainers/boots.												
<b>Outdoor Clothing</b>	Coats, scarfs. Students are not permitted to wear outdoor clothing during lessons.												
<b>Badges</b>	Only authorised badges are permitted e.g. House badges, achievement badges. Any item (eg. Kirpan) worn for religious reasons will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.												
<b>Hair</b>	No extremes of style (e.g. shaved lines, unnatural colouring). Hair ornaments should be discrete in size, design and colour, including hairbands. Headdress worn for religious reasons should be non-patterned.

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<b>Makeup</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>KS3</b> (Years 7 – 9)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Use of subtle foundation, concealer and/or mascara permitted.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>KS4</b> (Years 10 – 11)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">As per Year KS3, but subtle eyeliner is permitted, as is nail polish. Any nail polish must be a single colour. Acrylic nails and/or false eyelashes are not permitted.</p>
