Former BGS student Steven Murphy, now a teacher in our Mathematics Department, has successfully defended his PhD thesis at the University of Manchester and so has been granted his doctorate. He will henceforth be known as Dr Murphy. Dr Murphy reports that his thesis was concerned with the viability of diamond detectors in the Large Hadron Collider. His doctorate was confirmed after a *viva voce* examination earlier this week in Manchester. Two assessors spoke with him about his work, critiquing it, for four hours. Our warmest congratulations to Dr Murphy on this most impressive distinction and achievement.
