

2019 SIXTH FORM FNTRY CRITERIA

Students require a minimum of seven GCSE passes comprising:

- In every case you must achieve a Grade 4 or better in each of English Language and Mathematics
- In addition to the above, you must achieve a minimum of five 9-4 grades in any other subjects
- Choose three A-Level subjects from the twentyseven listed overleaf and check that you meet the subject-specific criteria

Biology	Grade 6 in Mathematics and either: Students who have studied Combined Science Trilogy: Grade 7-7 or Students who have studied Triple Award Science: Grade 7 in GCSE Biology
Business	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or Literature
Chemistry	Grade 7 in Mathematics and either: Students who have studied Combined Science Trilogy: Grade 7-7 or Students who have studied Triple Award Science: Grade 7 in GCSE Chemistry
Computer Science	Grade 6 in GCSE Computer Science or Grade 5 in GCSE Mathematics
Design Engineering	Grade 6 in GCSE Design Engineering/Design Technology or Grade 5 in GCSE Mathematics
Economics	Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics
English Language	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or Literature
English Literature	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or Literature
Environmental Science It is recommended that A-Level Biology and A-Level Environmental Science are not studied together	Grade 5 in English Language or Literature and: Students who have studied Combined Science Trilogy: Grade 6-6 or Students who have studied Triple Award Science: Grade 6 in GCSE Biology
Fine Art	Grade 6 in GCSE Art, if studied, or portfolio of artwork to be assessed by the Art Department
French	Grade 6 in GCSE French
Further Mathematics	Grade 8 in GCSE Mathematics
Geography	Grade 6 in GCSE Geography
German	Grade 6 in GCSE German

A-Level Subject	Subject-Specific Criteria (minimum required)
History	Grade 6 in GCSE History
Law	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or Literature
Mathematics	Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics
Media Studies	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or Literature
Music	Grade 6 in GCSE Music, if studied, or must be an able performer (Grade 5+) and will have undertaken theory work of Grade 5 standard
Physical Education Students who wish to study PE at A-Level should be active participants in competitive sport; the PE department can advise	Grade 6 in GCSE PE, if studied, or Students who have studied Combined Science Trilogy: Grade 6-6 or Students who have studied Triple Award Science: Grade 6 in GCSE Biology
Physics	Grade 7 in Mathematics and either: Students who have studied Combined Science Trilogy: Grade 7-7 or Students who have studied Triple Award Science: Grade 7 in GCSE Physics
Politics	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or Literature
Psychology	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or Literature, and Students who have studied Combined Science Trilogy: Grade 6-6 or Students who have studied Triple Award Science: Grade 6 in GCSE Biology
Religious Studies	Grade 6 in GCSE Religious Studies <i>or</i> Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or Literature
Sociology	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or Literature
Spanish	Grade 6 in GCSE Spanish
Theatre Studies	Grade 6 in GCSE Drama <i>or</i> Grade 5 in GCSE English Language or Literature
