Student Review Day - Friday 8 March 2019

Student Review Day (SRD) is an important day in the School calendar and is an opportunity for a one-to-one discussion with your son/daughter's tutor to explore his/her progress in detail. Students will be set work to complete at home on SRD (one hour of work per subject lesson timetabled on that day) and are expected to attend their meeting at School along with their parent(s)/carer(s).

The online booking system for Student Review Day will open on Friday 18 January 2019.

Information and guidance about SRD, including your login details and how to book your appointment online will be sent by email to *Priority 1* parents (as recorded on our database) on that day. Appointments will be available from 08:30 - 18:15 (last appointment) and are booked on a first-come, first-served basis.

2. Only one SRD appointment can be made per student, which will be offered to the *Priority 1* parent that the student lives with.
