




Why might we think of society as a human body?





Varnashrama Dharma – Critique:

Caste:

- Ashramas do not apply to dalits.
- Dalits are outside of the caste system.

Women:

- Ashramas do not apply to women.
- Women are believed to pass through 3 phases:
 - Child: protected by her father.
 - Spouse: protected by her husband.
 - Widow: protected by her eldest son.
- These phases are set out in the Laws of Manu.
