Term	Meaning
Biological Weapons	<i>A person who works to establish peace in the world or in a certain part of it.</i>
Chemical Weapons	<i>A war which meets internationally accepted criteria for fairness; follows traditional Christian rules for a just war, and is now accepted by all other religions.</i>
Forgiveness	<i>Acting to prevent harm to yourself or others.</i>
Greed	<i>An absence of conflict, which leads to happiness and harmony.</i>
Holy War	<i>An expression of disapproval, often in a public group.</i>
Just War	<i>Bringing about what is right and fair, according to the law or making up for a wrong that has been committed.</i>
Justice	<i>Deliberately harming someone as a response to them harming you.</i>
Nuclear Weapons	<i>Fighting between nations to resolve issues between them.</i>
Pacifism	<i>Fighting for a religious cause or God, probably controlled by a religious leader.</i>
Peace	<i>Selfish desire for something.</i>
Peace-maker	<i>Showing grace and mercy and pardoning someone for what they have done wrong.</i>
Peace-making	<i>The action of trying to establish peace.</i>
Protest	<i>The belief of people who refuse to take part in war and any other form of violence.</i>
Reconciliation	<i>The unlawful use of violence, usually against innocent civilians, to achieve a political goal.</i>
Retaliation	<i>Using actions that threaten or harm others.</i>
Self-defence	<i>Weapons that can kill large numbers of people and/or cause great damage.</i>
Terrorism	<i>Weapons that have living organisms or infective material that can lead to disease or death.</i>
Violence	<i>Weapons that use chemicals to poison, burn, or paralyse humans and destroy the natural environment.</i>
War	<i>Weapons that work by a nuclear reaction; they devastate huge areas and kill large numbers of people.</i>
Weapons of Mass Destruction	<i>When individuals or groups restore friendly relations after conflict or disagreement.</i>
