	<b>Black Uniform</b>	<b>Green Uniform</b>
<b>Blazer</b>	Black with School badge, worn at all times.	Dark green with School badge, worn at all times.
<b>Blouse</b>	N/A	Short-sleeved green and white striped fitted blouse (undergarments/T-shirts must not be visible through or below shirts)
<b>Shirt</b>	White, long or short-sleeved (must remain tucked in; undergarments/T-shirts must not be visible through shirt)	N/A
<b>Skirt</b>	N/A	Full length dark green and pleated (either with all round box pleats or all round knife pleats)
<b>Trousers</b>	Formal, black, no turn-ups	N/A
<b>Tights</b>	N/A	Plain, skin-coloured, or dark green
<b>Socks</b>	Black, unbranded	Dark green or black, unbranded
<b>Tie</b>	Black and white School tie, properly tied with length just above waistband. Top button must be fastened and not visible.	N/A
<b>Pullover/ Cardigan</b>	Black, plain, V-neck, knitted with long sleeves. Can be worn in addition to blazer but not on its own. Sweatshirts not permitted.	Dark green, plain, V-neck, knitted with long sleeves. Can be worn in addition to blazer but not on its own. Sweatshirts not permitted.
<b>Shoes</b>	Formal plain black leather or simulated leather, with low heel. Coloured or canvas shoes/trainers/boots are not permitted	
<b>Outdoor Clothing</b>	Overcoat/raincoat/duffel-coat/anorak that is dark in colour Students are not permitted to wear coats during lessons Students are permitted to wear the School hoodie to and from school and at break/lunch only	
<b>Scarf</b>	Any colour may be worn to and from school, but not within the School buildings during lessons or transition time	
<b>Badges</b>	Only authorised badges are permitted e.g. House badges, achievement badges	
<b>Hair</b>	No extremes of style (e.g. shaved lines, unnatural colouring). Hair ornaments should be discrete in size, design and colour, including hairbands. Headdress worn for religious reasons should be black, green or white and non-patterned.	
<b>Jewellery</b>	<b>Permitted:</b>  1 pair of ear studs 1 nose stud 1 ring 1 gold or silver necklace 1 bracelet	<b>Not Permitted:</b>  Hooped earrings Ear tunnels, tapers or tragus Lip piercings
<b>Makeup</b>	<b>KS3 (Years 7 – 9)</b> Use of subtle foundation, concealer and/or mascara permitted.  <b>KS4 (Years 10 – 11)</b> As per Year KS3, but subtle eyeliner is permitted, as is nail polish. Any nail polish must be a single colour. Acrylic nails and/or false eyelashes are not permitted.
