



Bourne Grammar School is an oversubscribed, mixed, selective school with a large Sixth Form. The vast majority of our Year 11 students transfer into the Sixth Form where they are offered a choice of 26 A-Level subjects.

The School has over 1700 pupils on roll from Years 7-13 and is one of the largest grammar schools in the country. The School has recently added to its facilities with a new Astroturf pitch and a £4 million Science Block consisting of 15 state-of-the-art laboratories.



### **The best atmosphere, the best support, the best results**

Bourne Grammar School's mission statement attaches great importance to the pursuit of academic excellence and equal importance to the levels of pastoral support for students. We believe that in the right atmosphere and with right support, given our able students and committed staff, good results will be achieved by our students. The School was recently rated overall as 'Good' by Ofsted in its inspection in October 2022 as our students want to learn and enjoy lessons which are well-taught and engaging. Both the Quality of Education within the School and the large 500-strong Sixth Form were rated as 'Outstanding' as part of that overall judgement.

The Behaviour and Attitudes of our students was also deemed 'Outstanding' by Ofsted with inspectors noting that, despite being a large and busy School, our students are well behaved and highly motivated.

Our examination results are impressive. Last year, at GCSE level, 90% of Year 11 students achieved 5 or more grade 9-4s including grade 4s in English and Maths. Our Progress 8 score is 0.76 placing us in the top 5% of schools nationally.

In terms of our A-Levels students, 90% of students achieved A\*-C grades with 85% of Year 13 students applying for University placements.



Excellent examination results are important but Bourne Grammar School believes that education is more than just what is learnt in the classroom.

The School has a comprehensive Careers Programme and offers an extensive range of extra-curricular clubs and societies, run by staff and sixth formers for the benefit of students. These run alongside many Sports clubs and academic societies. Applicants should indicate any personal interest in becoming involved in any club that forms part of our enrichment approach.



The School is led by the Headteacher, 4 Deputy Headteachers and 3 Assistant Headteachers. It comprises of approximately 100 teaching staff and approximately 50 non-teaching colleagues. The majority of teaching colleagues are only required to teach their own subject and also have a role of a Form Tutor.

The School values it's staff and provides excellent support for colleagues both professionally and personally. Joining Bourne Grammar School as you start or further your career will enable you to join a team of highly skilled practitioners in a unique working environment, with a welcoming, inclusive and nurturing culture.

The School also prides itself on its community links, working closely with local primary schools and local charities and its role in the town can be dated back to the 14th Century. In 2021, the School hosted a week of celebrations to honour the centenary of 100 years on our current site; in which every staff member and student participated.



Bourne Grammar School is situated in Bourne, South Lincolnshire. Bourne is a pleasant, semi-rural and expanding town and is surrounded by beautiful villages and countryside and yet has easy access to Sleaford, Grantham, Peterborough, Cambridge, London and the motorway network. London Kings Cross is approximately an hour by train from Peterborough. Lincolnshire and its neighbouring counties offer a wide range of housing considerably below the national average house price cost.

Primary school provision in the local area is excellent and there are a multitude of cultural and recreational activities available.
